Greetings:

You are expected to bring with you the necessary spill kits for the types and quantities of chemicals you want to bring on the ship. This is not provided by the ship. Please check with your local EH&S people to determine what kits to bring. Dry powder kits and bulk materials for liquid acids and liquid bases are commonly available, for example from: <http://www.npsc corp.com/spilfyter/kit>

I very highly recommend that you bring liquid reagents in plastic bottles whenever possible (diluted as much as possible) and minimize your need for concentrated HCl or HNO<sub>3</sub> or ammonium hydroxide.
